## Outcomes Information for the most recent three class years (15, 16, & 17) the following information is provided:

- Graduation rates for these three years are: 2015 89.5%, 2016 83.3 %, and 2017- 88.3%. This data reflects that reported to CAPTE and is based on completion of students offered a position in the class.
- Over ninety percent (> 90%) of students who begin the Fall Semester of the technical year of the PTA program during these three years successfully completed the PTA program. Over 80% of students who were offered an initial position in a class ultimately completed the program successfully.
- Graduates over this period have over a 95% first time pass rate and a 100% ultimate pass rate on the NPTE licensure examination.
- Graduates who sought employment report finding jobs within 6 months
  of graduation. Graduates from the classes 2014, 2015, and 2016 report high job
  satisfaction (> 90%) on graduate surveys. The graduate survey for the class of
  2017 will be completed in 2018 and results will be added to this information as
  available.
- Supervising PTs and employers report graduates performing at appropriate entry level (>94%) and that they would hire a graduate from the MSC PTA program again.
