Outcomes Information for the most recent three class years (2019, 2020, 2021) the following information is provided:

- Graduation rates for these three years are: 2019 81.2%, 2020 83%, and 2021 83%. This data reflects that reported to CAPTE and is based on completion of students offered a position in the class.
- Over ninety percent (> 90%) of students who begin the Fall Semester of the technical year of the PTA program during these three years successfully completed the PTA program. Over 80% of students who were offered an initial position in a class ultimately completed the program successfully.
- Graduates during this period have over a 90% first time pass rate and a 95 % ultimate pass rate on the NPTE licensure examination.
- Graduates who sought employment report finding jobs within 6 months
 of graduation. Graduates from these classes report high job satisfaction (> 90%) on
 graduate surveys.
- Supervising PTs and employers report graduates performing at appropriate entry level and that they would hire a graduate from the MSC PTA program again. (>94%)
